DoD's Impact on Virginia's Economy: Summary, FFY2008



- ❑ Virginia is the third largest DoD employer.
- ❑ Virginia is second to Texas in total per state expenditures. California is a close third.
- ❑ Virginia receives the highest per capita DoD spending in the U.S. (\$7,000).
- ❑ Florida a distant fourth.
- ❑ Contracting in Virginia is nearly \$40 billion.
- ❑ The major activity takes place along or east of I-95.

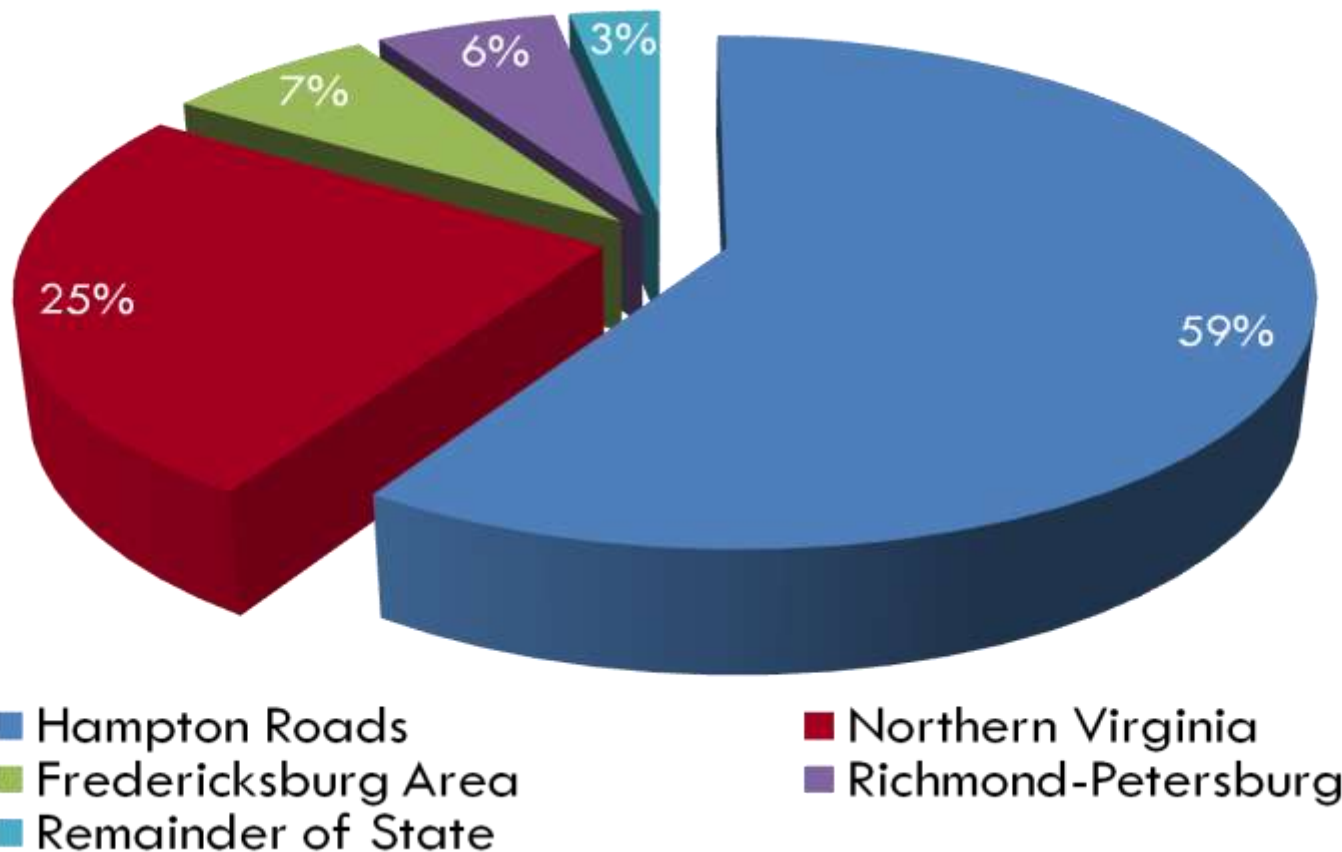
DoD Employment by State: FFY2008

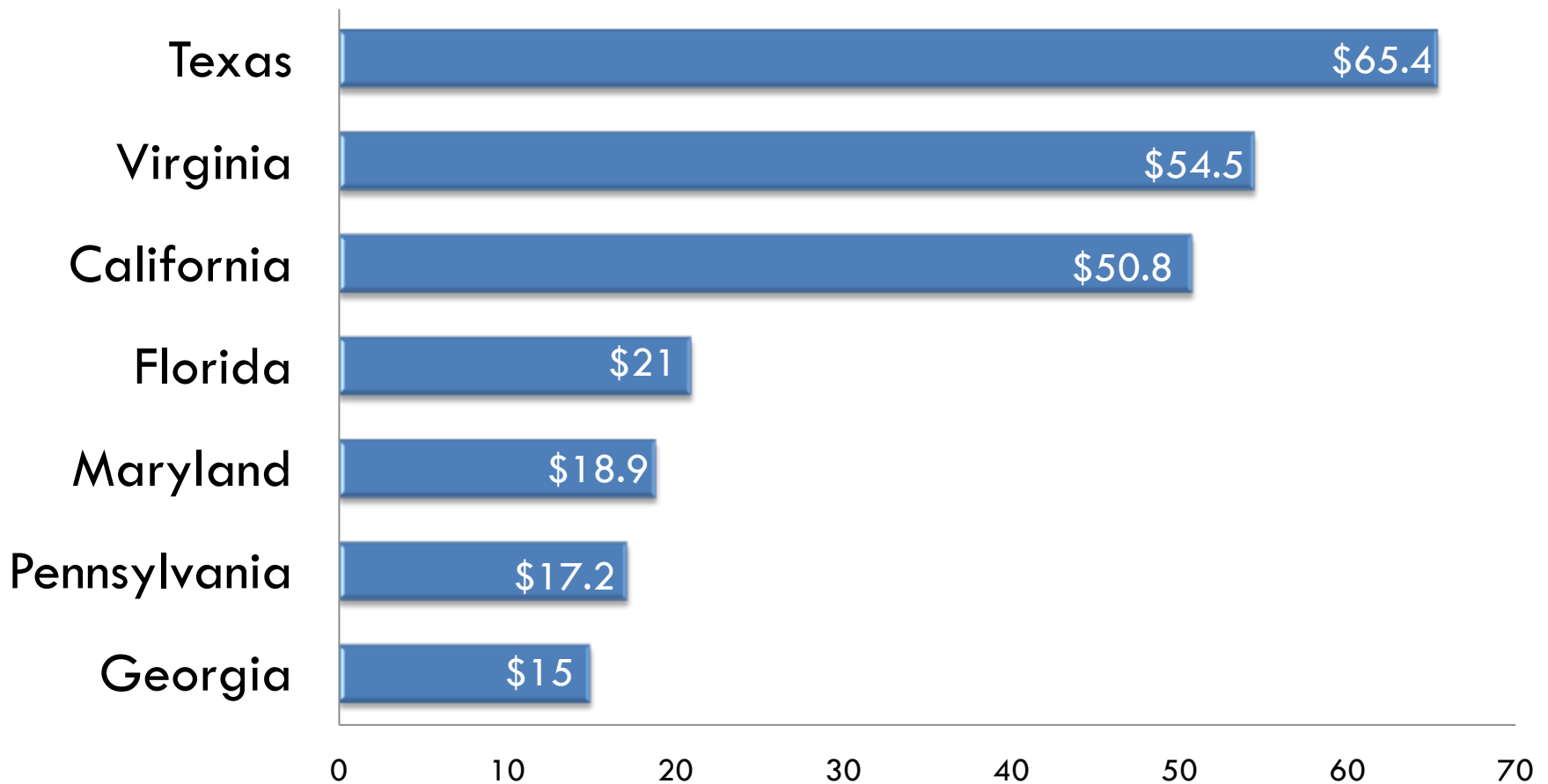
DoD Employment by Region



DoD Total Spending by State: FFY2008



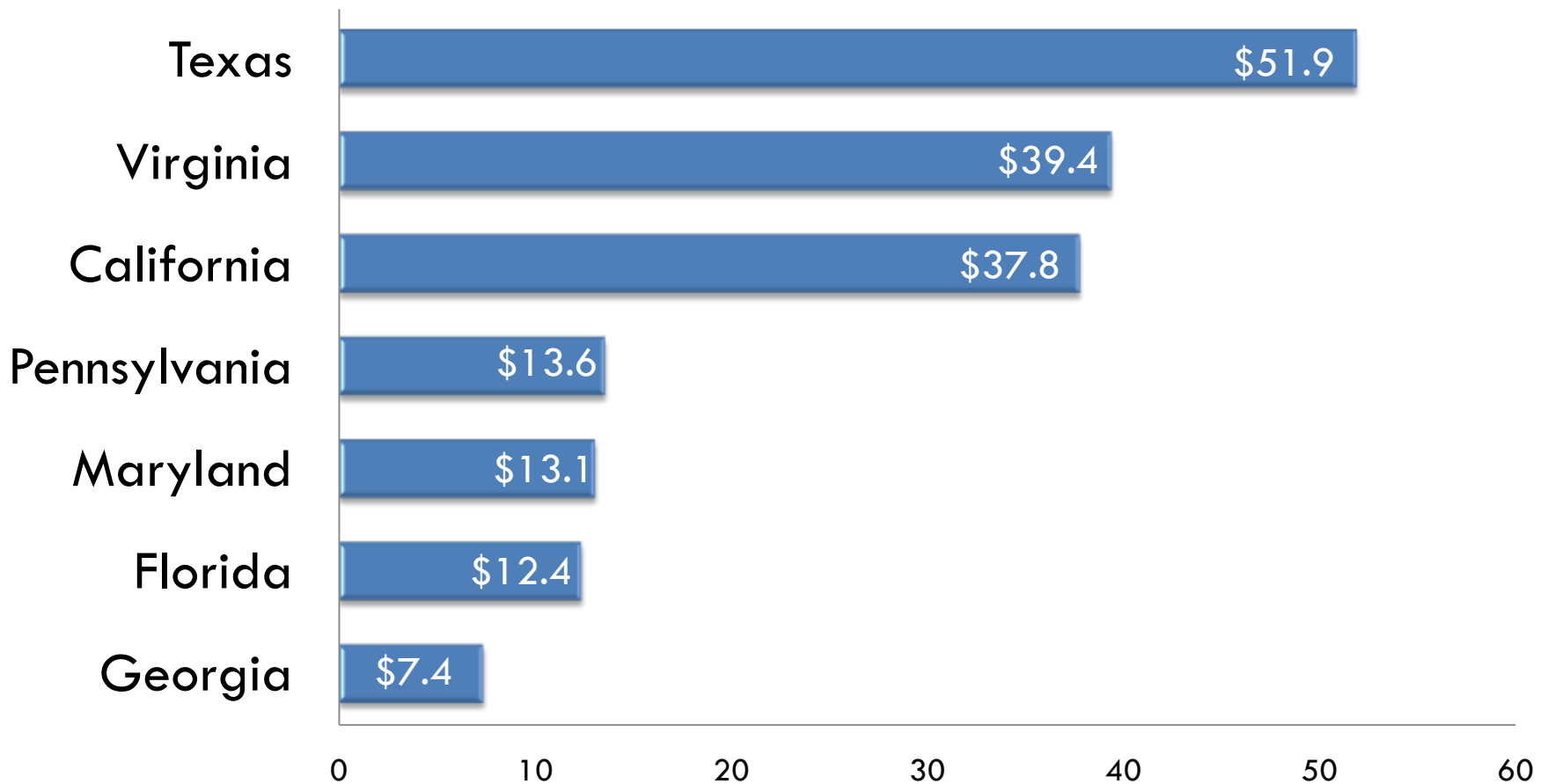
